## Summary

FinanceMap is an online, publicly available platform from global climate-risk think tank InfluenceMap that examines the asset management sector through a climate lens. Users can analyze asset managers' climate performance on portfolios, investor-engagement processes, and shareholder resolutions using industry-recognized benchmarking standards.

FinanceMap applies the market-leading Paris Agreement Capital Transition Assessment (PACTA) methodology, developed by the 2 Degrees Investing Initiative, to a universe of over 70,000 funds managed by over 1,000 asset management groups globally. This methodology assesses the alignment of portfolios with the Paris Agreement.

In-depth analysis of the corporate stewardship programs and climate-related proxy voting behavior of the world's 30 largest asset managers can also be accessed through the asset manager profile pages. FinanceMap's methodology to measure the corporate stewardship programs on climate indicators was developed in consultation with several of the world's leading asset managers and is benchmarked against the UK Financial Reporting Council's Stewardship Code 2020.

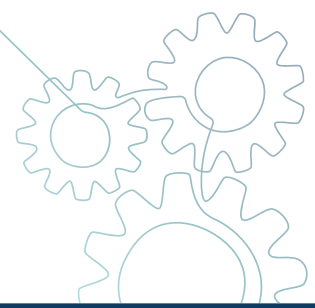
