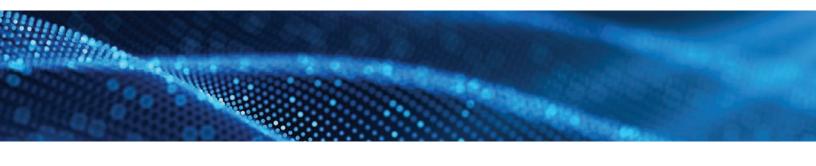

Summary

MSCI's Climate Risk Portfolio Level Reporting Tool is designed to provide institutional investors with transparency into their portfolios' climate-related risks and opportunities, according to the recommendations from the Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosures (TCFD). The report contains a climate risk dashboard showing portfolio-level and benchmark-level results from both backward- and forward-looking climate-related analyses, including analyses of carbon footprints, fossil fuel exposure, low-carbon transition risks and opportunities, and companies' transition plans and targets. The report also includes a portfolio alignment assessment (MSCI Implied Temperature Rise) and climate scenario analysis (MSCI Climate VaR).
